

History

The band –Need of Activity- was founded in autumn 1995 in a small town called Hostinné situated under the Giant Mountains.

The first concert took place in Vrchlabí in –Lágr- several months later. No member of the band was able to think out a name and so the drummer simply said to the organizers: - We are Need of Activity- and a name was born.

The musical exhibition of the band could be called as disastrous, but thanks to litres of alcohol drunk by audience the performance was successful.

There were some personal changes at that time and the band (with new members) began concerting through East Bohemia. In spring 1996 the band recorded a demoCD with three songs. –Nádraží-, -Bungee Jumping- and –Nebaví-, which received a good criticism. The genre they played was so called Big Beat and everyone of them was proud of it.

Then came another personal changes due to disagreements in the band. Thanks to the new members the sound of the band changed. The music was close to funk and was accompanied by rap vocal.

With this new face the band won the second prize in competition called –Rock East Bohemia 1997- and recorded the second demoCD.

Another personal changes were done because of the same reason as before and another genre change came. Since that time the music indisputably has been Hard-Core-Rap.

The third demoCD was recorded in 1999. The demoCD as well as live shows are based on a modern sound and English lyrics.

Members still change, but genre stays. The band moved from Hostinné to Jilemnice (about 30 km far from Harachov) and plays all around the Czech Republic and even in Poland and Germany.

In spring 2003 the fourth and for the present the last demoCD –Mechanical Peace- was recorded.

There haven't been any other personal changes and genre changes since spring 2003 and we hope there won't be any more.

The only original and founder member still playing in Need of Activity is Brohe.
